The Centre for Integrated Therapies provides complementary health practitioners with an exclusive and professional working space in the centre of Bath. Two rooms are available; a therapy room equipped with an electronic massage couch, desk and accessories; and a consulting room with seating for four clients plus the therapist and a desk. There is also a comfortable waiting room, a toilet, kitchen facilities and a garden. All rooms are maintained to the highest standard in terms of décor and equipment. The Centre for Integrated Therapies advertises in The Bath Magazine as well as in local and national directories, online and by a program of direct marketing. All marketing directs potential clients to the website, and the website will include details of all practitioners working at the clinic. Bookings are taken centrally throughout office hours on our appointment line which is staffed by professional reception staff and messages are also taken for practitioners. Clients pay for all treatments centrally, full card facilities are available, and therapists are paid that amount weekly, less their rental payment for the room. Therapists are required to submit a client log to enable the calculation of room rental.

Rooms are available Monday to Friday in two sessions; 11.00am-3.00pm and 3.30pm-7.30pm, and on Saturdays from 9am-1pm. Room rental per session is £35.00 per four hour session or 30% of total session earnings.

Please read the information below and if you would like to submit an expression of interest please do so by email, addressing all the points below, on mail@centreforintegratedtherapies.com. Please also include a CV, and a short profile.

1. All practitioners must hold appropriate qualifications in the form of therapy they intend to practice. They should have been qualified for at least one year and must be able to show current certification.
2. All practitioners must be members of their professional accrediting body.
3. All practitioners must show evidence of current valid insurance covering them for all liability in the field of therapy they intend to practice. It is the practitioner's responsibility to maintain their own liability insurance, although the clinic is also separately insured.
4. All practitioners must have a current first aid certificate and must ensure that their first aid training remains current while practicing at The Centre for Integrated Therapies.
5. All practitioners must have an existing client list. Practitioners are responsible for maintaining and expanding their own client list but may use The Centre for Integrated Therapies logo when undertaking personal advertising regarding their practice here, in consultation with us.
6. All practitioners must be self-employed or operate as a company as payments are made to you as a contractor not an employee.
7. All practitioners should be committed to the principles of holistic health care and undertake to participate in ongoing professional development in their field.
8. All practitioners are expected to refer clients internally where possible.
9. Practitioners must commit to booking at least one session per week on a recurring basis. Sessions booked will be invoiced regardless of client attendance. One month's notice is required to relinquish a session.
